The Finishing Technician will support the HQ team to deliver projects on time within the HQ paint schedule.

Key Responsibilities:

- Preparing materials including filling & sanding and preparing surfaces using metal, wood or plastic part to sand or ground surface.
- Responsible for ensuring all surfaces are prepared to give the best possible finish.
- Applying primer coats using spray guns and rub down surfaces between coats.
- Mixing paints using a schemed database system.
- Developing spraying skills by working in a spray booth.
- Using internal ERP system for signing off stages in production.
- Clearly communicate all relevant information including job progress and any problems and/or issues.
- Communicate in a positive manner with other team members and departments.

QUALIFICATIONS
